The proliferative phase of wound healing restores skin integrity by filling in the wound with new tissue. New blood vessels form within the wound by extending from the wound's edges; this is called angiogenesis. The fragile and highly permeable capillaries that form first allow easy passage of fluid, often leading to some swelling.
