It became recognized that no local jurisdiction, whether criminal or civil, could be exercised over the sovereign. The rule was later extended to republican heads of state.

The Maastricht Principles on States' extraterritorial obligations (ETOs) summarize the human rights obligations States have towards people living in other countries. 1 They focus on economic, social and cultural rights (ESC rights) but can to a large extent also be applied to civil and political rights.

Extraterritorial jurisdiction is the situation when a state extends its legal power beyond its territorial boundaries. Examples include where a state maintains jurisdiction over its citizens when they are overseas, and where certain criminal offences can be prosecuted in a state regardless of where they were committed (e.g. piracy and child sex offences).
