"In order for a drug to be approved by the FDA, the manufacturer has to show that it will remain stable for up to three years," says pharmacist Lee Cantrell, professor of clinical pharmacy and director of the San Diego division of the California Poison Control System.

Take medicine on time. Some people use meals or bedtime as reminders to take their medicine. Other people use charts, calendars, or weekly pill boxes. You can also set timers and write reminders to take your medication. Turn on a light. Don't take medicine in the dark; otherwise, you might make a mistake.
