The Great Tapestry of Scotland is not currently available to public display. The Tapestry will move to a new, purpose built, permanent home in the Spring of 2021 and while that is being built, any remedial work required will be undertaken away from public view.

The Scottish Royal tapestry collection was a group of tapestry hangings assembled to decorate the palaces of sixteenth-century kings and queens of Scotland ... in June 1578 "certain great pieces of tapestry" and coffer of furnishings were loaded on a boat at Leith and shipped to Cambuskenneth and the castle.

The Great Tapestry of Scotland tells the story of the making of a masterpiece depicting 420 million years of Scottish history and achievement. It involved a thousand stitchers from all over Scotland who worked on the 165 separate panels. The idea was the brainchild of Alexander McCall Smith who writes the foreword to the book.

Strictly speaking this is not a tapestry as the whole work is a series of embroidered and not woven pictures – just like the Bayeux Tapestry. It is annotated variously in English, Gaelic, Latin and Scots. Scottish author Alexander McCall Smith came up with the idea of stitching the entire story of Scotland from pre-history to modern times.
